

Three Day Multi Sports Camp will be held at the Franklin Park Adventure Center June 13-15, 2011. **Summer Day Camp Sessions 1-7 June 20– Aug. 5** will run five days, Monday through Friday. Hours of operation will be **8:30-3:00** with early drop off at **7:15 AM** and late pick up by **5:15 PM**, Monday through Thursday. Friday we will have special hours **8:30 –2:00** with early drop off at **7:15 AM**. There will be an additional fee for early drop and/or late pick up. **There are no late pick ups on Fridays! Session 3 will run Tuesday through Friday at both locations due to the holiday.**

No camp on July 4th.

Parent Camp Orientation-Thursday, May 19th at 6:30 PM. Please plan on attending. This is a great time to meet the Camp Directors and fill out paperwork before camp starts.

Campers must be 6 years or older at the start of camp.

Transportation is **not** available to and from camp. Transportation from both centers is provided for trips taken during the camp day while at camp.

Medications are self administered unless staff has written permission from a parent/guardian to assist.

P.L.A.Y. scholarships are available to the campers who qualify for one session only. Please call for application, or stop by any Recreation Center.
