Cultural Arts Center's "Fragmented Histories" Exhibit Opens

The Columbus Recreation and Parks Department's Cultural Arts Center (CAC) will present the works of a local artist Mona Gazala. Rooted in a lifelong fascination with archaeology, Mona Gazala's experimental and installation artworks make lyrical connections between ancient ruins and the derelict or abandoned industrial and domestic structures within our own modern post-industrial cities.
