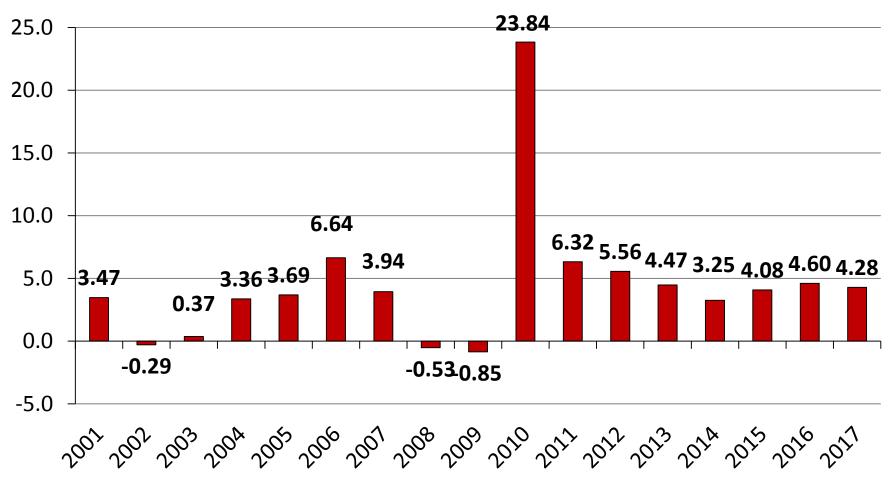

- Columbus was the **third city in the USA** to have a municipal income tax (1948) after Philadelphia (1939) and Toledo, OH (1947).
- Columbus has experienced five "negative growth" years since 1948, the first year of collections. Three of those years have occurred since 2002.
- Collections in 2017 were \$875.9 million with 75% (\$656.9) going to the General Operating Fund and 25% (\$219.0) going to the Debt Service Fund.

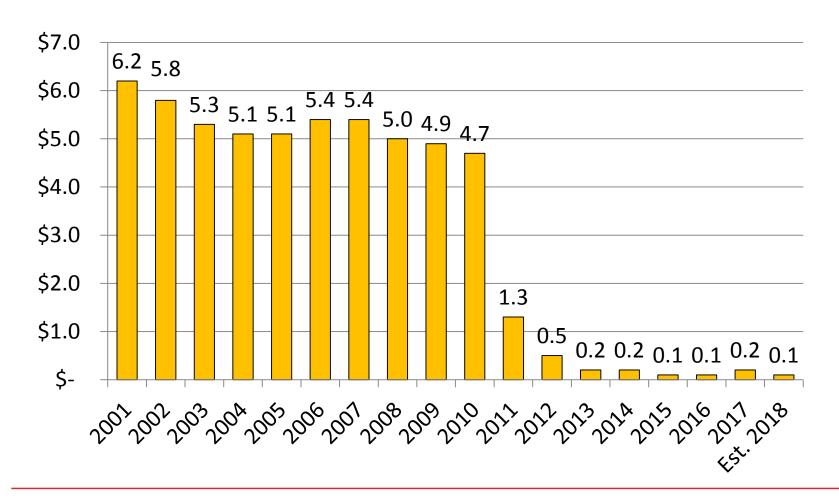

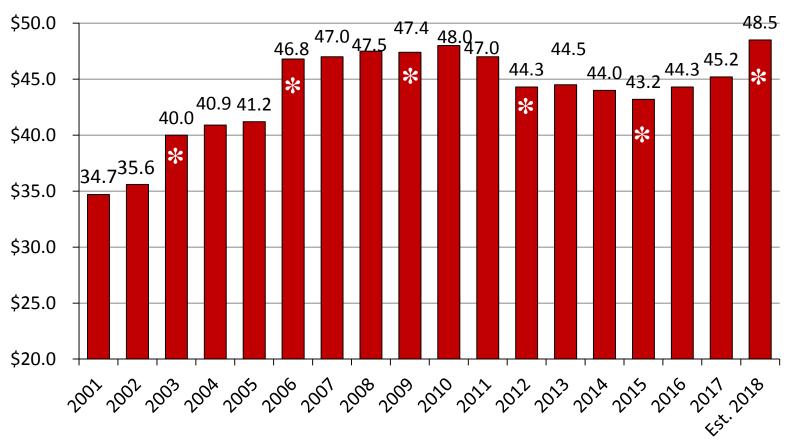

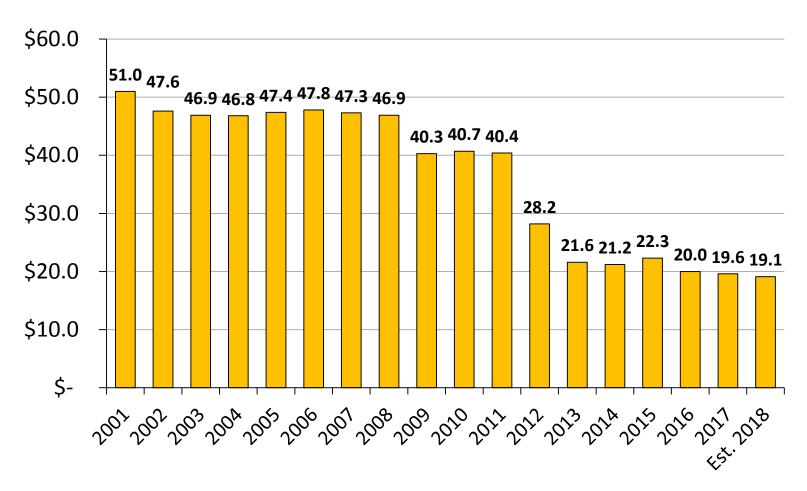

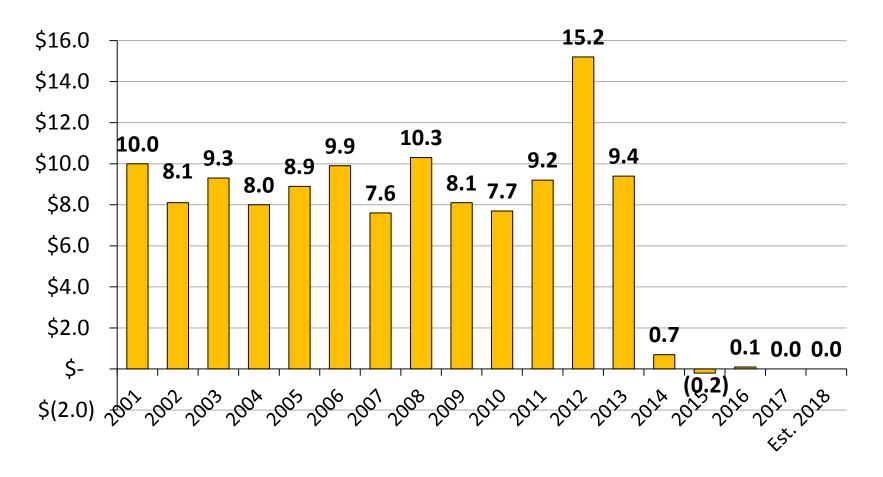


#### City of Columbus, Ohio Local Government Funds (in millions)

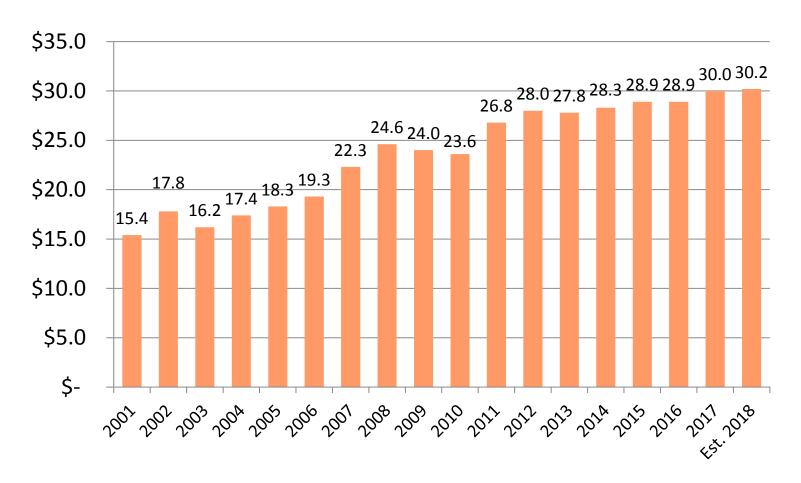

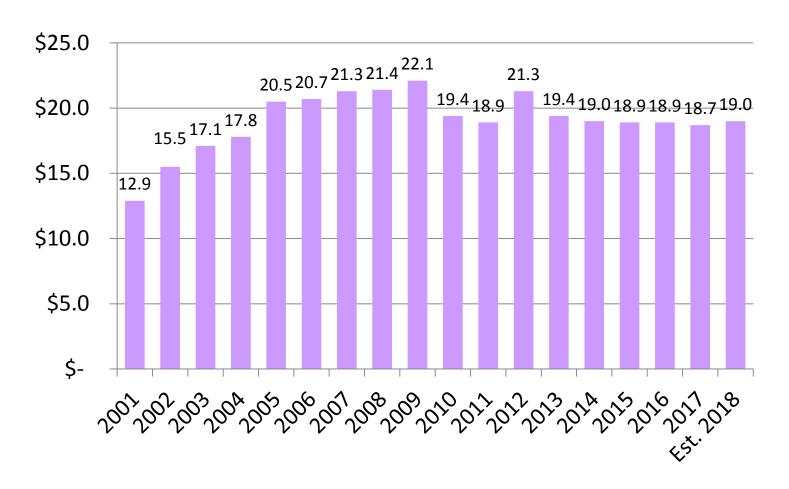

## City of Columbus, Ohio Charges to Other Funds- Pro Rata (in millions)



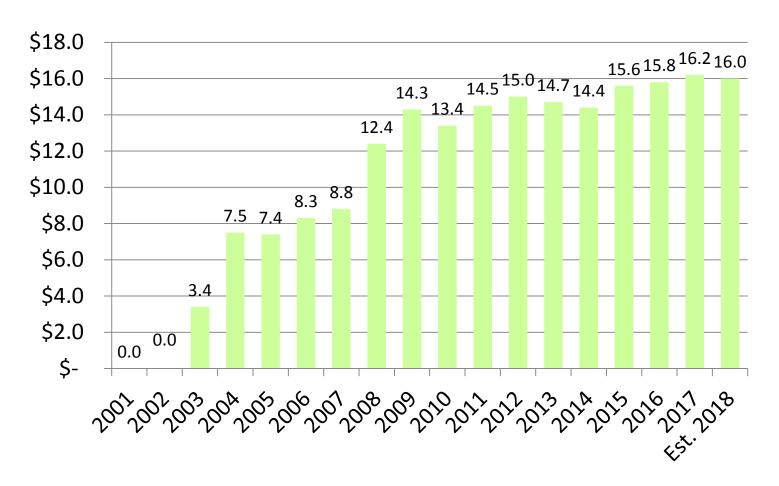


### City of Columbus, Ohio Charges to Other Funds- Fines (in millions)

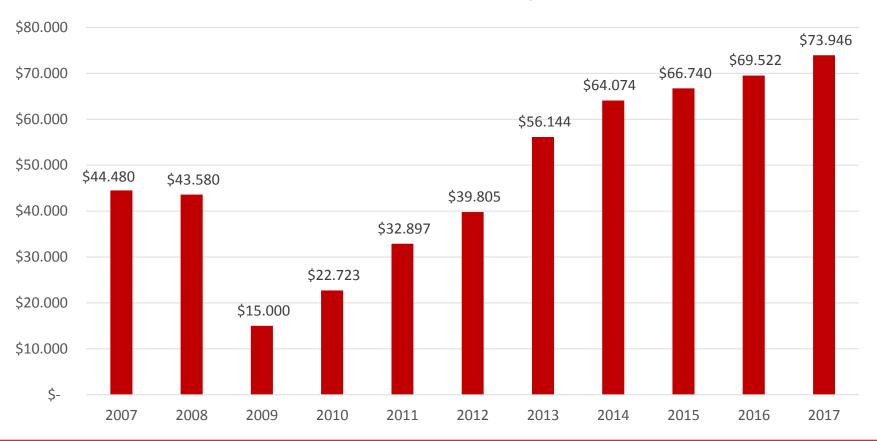
