

## **Notice of Neighborhood Stabilization Program 3 (NSP3) Application**

**The City of Columbus now has available for public review and comment, information on a substantial amendment to the Consolidated Plan's 2010 Action Plan. The proposed amendment describes the city's implementation plan and application for the Neighborhood Stabilization Program 3 (NSP3) grant, a Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) program to provide emergency assistance to acquire and redevelop foreclosed properties that might otherwise become sources of abandonment and blight within the community. The City of Columbus will receive from HUD \$4,843,460 in NSP3 funds and plans to purchase foreclosed or abandoned properties as well as rehabilitate, redevelop or demolish these properties in order to stabilize neighborhoods and stem the decline of values of neighboring homes.**
