6-	Have you been taking at least 15 milligrams of steroids each day for a month or more?		
7-	Are you taking TNF-alpha antagonists?		
8-	Do you have any of the following chronic medical problems (Silicosis, diabetes, kidney disease, or cancer of the lung, head, or neck)?		
9-	Have you traveled outside the United States since your last TB test?		
10-	Are you a healthcare worker?		
11-	Do you use IV drugs?		
12-	Are you living or working in a group setting (homeless shelter, jail/prison, nursing home, group home)?		
13-	Are you HIV positive?		

If you answered "YES" to **ANY** of these questions:

It is recommended that you be screened for tuberculosis.

If you answered "NO" to **ALL** these above questions:

It is **NOT** recommended that you be screened for Tuberculosis.
