

## **Active Living City Advisory Committee Development, Public Service policy accomplishments, 2008-2009**

### **Department of Development**

- In 2008 the commercial overlays were amended to reduce parking requirements as a way of encouraging additional development, as well as reinforcing the walk friendly and bicycle friendly goals of the urban and community commercial overlays.
- In 2009 four sets of overlays were adopted by Council (Eastmoor: Broad and Main Streets; Northwest: Sawmill, SR161 and Bethel; Southside: Lockbourne Road; and Milo-Grogan: Cleveland and Fifth Avenues). All four sets require a pedestrian-friendly built environment and encourage walking and biking.
- The Planning Division continues to promote higher density, mixed use development along older commercial corridors with the goal of encouraging walking and biking as part of its area and neighborhood planning. This was particularly true in plans for Clintonville, Fifth by Northwest, Scioto/Southland, Southwest, and Livingston East.
- In 2009 the Planning Division and BSD were working together on parking code revisions, which include among a variety of recommendations a new requirement for bicycle parking. Those code changes are to be presented to Council later this fall.

High Street Share the Road Campaign – initiated May, 2009

Bicycle and scooter parking in new parking garage at Front & Rich – completed July, 2009

Roberts Road bike lanes – roadway widening project was completed July, 2009

Weinland Park Community Mobility Plan – to be completed September, 2009

Hilltop Community Mobility Plan – to be completed December, 2009
