Columbus is served by Port Columbus International Airport, which currently offers over 150 non-stop flights to 33 cities. Eleven major carriers provide direct flights to locations such as Atlanta, Chicago, New York, Miami and Las Vegas. Close to many population centers in the eastern United States, Columbus is a major logistics and distribution location. Rickenbacker International Airport is an international multi-modal cargo airport, a charter passenger terminal and offers a foreign trade zone for international cargo.
