Each proposal shall contain the full name and address of every person, firm or corporation interested in the same, and if corporation, the name and address of the President and Secretary.

EQUAL OPPORTUNITY CLAUSE: Each responsive bidder shall submit, with its bid, a contract compliance certification number or a completed application for certification. Compliance with the provisions of Article I, Title 39, is a condition of the contract. Failure to comply with this Article may result in cancellation of the contract.

WITHHOLDING OF INCOME TAX: All bidders are advised that in order for a contract to bind the City, each contract must contain the provisions found in Section 361.34 C.C.C. with regard to income taxes due or payable to the City of Columbus for wages, salaries and commissions paid to the contractor's employees as well as requiring those contractors to ensure that subcontractors withhold in a like manner.

DELINQUENT PERSONAL PROPERTY TAX: All bidders are charged with notice of Section 5719.042 of the Ohio Revised Code and agree that if this contract is awarded to them, the successful bidder, prior to the time the contract is entered into, will submit to the City Auditor the affidavit required by said section of the Ohio Revised Code. Said affidavit, when filed with City Auditor, is thereby incorporated into and made a part of this contract and no payment shall be made with respect to this contract unless such statement has been so incorporated as a part thereof.

LOCAL CREDIT: For all contracts EXCEPT PROFESSIONAL SERVICE CONTRACTS: In determining the lowest bid for purpose of awarding a contract not exceeding \$20,000.00, a local bidder shall receive a credit equal to five percent (5%) of the lowest bid submitted by a non-local bidder. In determining the lowest bid for purposes of awarding a contract in excess of \$20,000.00, a local bidder shall receive a credit equal to one percent (1%) or \$20,000.00, whichever is less, of the lowest bid submitted by a non-local bidder. A local bidder is a person, corporation or business which (a) has listed its principal place of business as being located within the corporation limits of the City of Columbus or the County of Franklin in official documents filed with Secretary of State, State of Ohio, or a valid vendor's license which indicates its place of business is located within the corporation limits of the City of Columbus or County of Franklin.

PROPOSAL GUARANTY

"No proposal will be considered unless accompanied by a bond or certified check drawn on a solvent bank made payable to the City of Columbus, Ohio, in an amount not less than 10 percent of the Bidder's Proposal, conditioned upon execution of the contract and the furnishing of a performance bond in the event the contract is awarded to the bidder. The amount of the bid bond shall be expressed either as a percentage of the total bid (10%) or numerically in dollars and cents. The amount indicated in the proposal bond shall include the total amount of the bid including all alternates submitted which increase the bid. The bond amount shall be equal to or exceed 10 percent of this total amount. "

PREVAILING WAGE RATE

Attention of the bidder is called to the special requirements included in the Bid Submittal Documents regarding prevailing rates of wages to be paid.

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CONTRACT PERFORMANCE AND PAYMENT BOND

A contract performance and payment bond of 100 percent of the amount of the contract will be required to assure the faithful performance of the work. The City of Columbus, Ohio is inviting professional engineering consulting firms, or teams including such firms, to submit Proposals to furnish professional services for the City of Columbus, Department of Public Utilities, Division of Sewerage and Drainage (DOSD), to serve as Design Professionals (DPs) for projects that currently are in Concept Initiation by DOSD's Program Manager for Project No. 650390.1, Professional Program Management Services for 2006-2010 CIP Program. The VARIOUS PROJECTS ARE LISTED BELOW.

The Director of Public Utilities of the City of Columbus wishes to receive sealed Proposals from professional engineering firms interested in, and qualified for, furnishing professional services for any number of the following Capital Improvement Projects:

1. CIP 247 Jackson Pike Wastewater Treatment Plant, A-Plant Wet Weather Hydraulic Improvements.
2. CIP 359 Southerly Wastewater Treatment Plant, Sludge Thickening Improvements and Additional Renovations.
3. CIP 363 Southerly Wastewater Treatment Plant, New Effluent Pump Station and Effluent Conduit.
4. CIP 364 Southerly Wastewater Treatment Plant, Headworks, Part 2.

General Description

Currently, the City's Professional Program Management team (PPM) is doing Concept Initiation and/or Preliminary Design for the above listed projects at three levels of effort:

- Category 1 - Project Briefs
- Category 2 - Preliminary Engineering Report and Sketches
- Category 3 - Detailed Design Memorandum

The levels of effort vary because projects range from simple to complex and from well defined to technically undeveloped relative to the City's Wastewater Management Plan.

The intent is for the selected offerors to take the PPM's Concept Initiation, Preliminary Engineering Report, or Detailed Design Memorandum, adopt it, complete the PPM's Detailed Design Memorandum if necessary, and prepare and deliver detailed, biddable construction contract drawings in 6 (six) months. The PPM will overview each design effort in accordance with its existing Contract with the City.

The offeror's scopes of work will be thoroughly explained and finalized during the negotiation process.

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The Projects are categorized as follows:

Category

1. Category 1 Projects: CIP 247, CIP 367
2. Category 2 Projects: CIP 364
3. Category 3 Projects: CIP 359, CIP 363, CIP 366

General Description

The City of Columbus, Ohio has entered into two consent orders with the State of Ohio to address the capacity of the separate and combined collection systems and wastewater treatment plants including the operation, maintenance, management, capacity, and improvements of the City's collection systems and wastewater treatment facilities. Under these orders, the Wet Weather Management Plant (WWMP) dated July 1, 2005, has been prepared. The WWMP includes a large program of capital improvements, of which a portion must begin immediately and be substantially complete by July 1, 2010.

The City of Columbus is absolutely committed to meeting the agreed-upon schedule for this program. The City seeks to hire experienced DPs to provide detailed design services to accomplish those technically demanding and aggressively scheduled capital improvements projects.

Selection Process

Proposals will be reviewed by the City, and one firm will be selected for each project to negotiate a contract. Should negotiations fail with the selected firm, new negotiations may begin with the runner-up firm(s).

Selection of professional services for this work shall conform to all applicable requirements of Columbus City Codes, 1959, particularly Title 39 and Section 329.14 thereof. All offerors and all subcontract entities proposed shall have City of Columbus Contract Compliance Certificate Numbers (CCCNs). Offerors shall include a listing of CCCNs for themselves and their proposed subcontractors in their Proposals, or shall include completed applications for certification. Proposals shall be furnished in five (5) identical copies. The proposal shall clearly state which project(s) are being proposed upon. In the offeror's proposal, both the transmittal letter and Section 1 shall clearly state the project(s) for which the offeror desires to be considered. The proposal shall be clearly marked "Proposal for the Design Professional Services for Wastewater Treatment Plants 2006-2010 Capital Improvements Projects". Proposals shall be bound in plastic 3-ring binders.

2. After receipt of the Proposals, the Evaluation Committee will evaluate the submittals based on the criteria specified at the end of this document. A separate evaluation will be prepared for each project listed in the offeror's proposal. The Evaluation Committee will select one (1) qualified offeror for each project for contract negotiations. If the Evaluation Committee receives only one (1) proposal for a project, it may select that proposal or re-advertise at its option. The Evaluation Committee may select the same offeror for more than one project.

All offerors please note: The Evaluation Committee, in advance, appreciates your willingness to facilitate the review and scoring of your proposal by organizing the information to be reviewed and scored in an orderly and explicit tabularization which follows the City's experience requirements and distribution of points contained in the sections "Minimum Qualifications" and "Evaluation Points".

3. The Committee may also request that some offerors make a presentation to the Committee to elaborate on their proposals and/or any other pertinent information.

4. The Committee will submit its selected offeror for each project, along with a written explanation of the

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basis for the selection, to the Director of the Department of Public Utilities for final approval.

5. Contract negotiations will then commence with the selected offeror for each project. If negotiations fail, negotiations will be terminated, and the City may enter into negotiations with the runner-up offeror for each project. The City intends to strive for legislative action by October 1, 2006.

Evaluation Criteria

Each proposal will initially be evaluated as to whether the proposed team meets the established minimum qualifications to perform the work competently for each project listed in the offeror's proposal. Only teams meeting these minimum qualifications will be evaluated further using the points.

Minimum Qualifications

1. The Team must demonstrate experience with design and implementation of large scale, similar treatment plant improvements projects (greater than 30 MGD nominal design flow). Successful Teams will demonstrate treatment plant improvement experience directly related to the projects to which the offeror is proposing. In addition, Teams proposing for:

- a. CIP 359 must demonstrate prior experience with sludge handling process in a treatment plant of 60 MGD or greater;
- b. CIP 363 must demonstrate prior experience with pump station design of 100 MGD or greater;
- c. CIP 364 must demonstrate prior experience with hydraulic flow splitting structure design of 100 MGD or greater;
- d. CIP 366 must demonstrate prior experience with clarifier design of 25 MGD for each clarifier with a total or aggregate capacity of at least 75 MGD.
- e. CIP 367 must demonstrate prior experience with primary tank design of 11 MGD each and aeration tank design of 7 MGD each.

2. The Team must have successful experience in reviewing shop drawings, including equipment for wastewater treatment plant projects with construction cost over \$10 million each.
