**EQUAL OPPORTUNITY CLAUSE:** Each responsive bidder shall submit, with its bid, a contract compliance certification number or a completed application for certification. Compliance with the provisions of Article I, Title 39, is a condition of the contract. Failure to comply with this Article may result in cancellation of the contract.

**LOCAL CREDIT:** For all contracts EXCEPT PROFESSIONAL SERVICE CONTRACTS: In determining the lowest bid for purpose of awarding a contract not exceeding \$20,000.00, a local bidder shall receive a credit equal to five percent (5%) of the lowest bid submitted by a non-local bidder. In determining the lowest bid for purposes of awarding a contract in excess of \$20,000.00, a local bidder shall receive a credit equal to one percent (1%) or \$20,000.00, whichever is less, of the lowest bid submitted by a non-local bidder. For the DRIVING PARK DOWNSPOUT ELIMINATION PILOT PROJECT CIP 698, the City of Columbus, Division of Sewerage and Drainage, is proposing to undertake a set of improvements to eliminate sources of inflow and infiltration from private property of select homes in the Driving Park neighborhood from the public sanitary sewer system. As part of the improvements, work will include the disconnection of downspouts from private residences and re-directing roof water to one of several ultimate disposal strategies, which include splash pads and rain emitters. Permission to enter private property is being handled through Homeowner Agreements signed by property owners.

This project includes any such work as may be necessary to complete the contract in accordance with the plans (CC-14680) and specifications.
