Each proposal shall contain the full name and address of every person, firm or corporation interested in the same, and if corporation, the name and address of the President and Secretary.

EQUAL OPPORTUNITY CLAUSE: Each responsive bidder shall submit, with its bid, a contract compliance certification number or a completed application for certification. Compliance with the provisions of Article I, Title 39, is a condition of the contract. Failure to comply with this Article may result in cancellation of the contract.

WITHHOLDING OF INCOME TAX: All bidders are advised that in order for a contract to bind the City, each contract must contain the provisions found in Section 361.34 C.C.C. with regard to income taxes due or payable to the City of Columbus for wages, salaries and commissions paid to the contractor's employees as well as requiring those contractors to ensure that subcontractors withhold in a like manner.

Said affidavit, when filed with City Auditor, is thereby incorporated into and made a part of this contract and no payment shall be made with respect to this contract unless such statement has been so incorporated as a part thereof.

LOCAL CREDIT: For all contracts EXCEPT PROFESSIONAL SERVICE CONTRACTS: In determining the lowest bid for purpose of awarding a contract not exceeding \$20,000.00, a local bidder shall receive a credit equal to five percent (5%) of the lowest bid submitted by a non-local bidder. In determining the lowest bid for purposes of awarding a contract in excess of \$20,000.00, a local bidder shall receive a credit equal to one percent (1%) or \$10,000.00, whichever is less, of the lowest bid submitted by a non-local bidder. A local bidder is a person, corporation or business which (a) has listed its principal place of business as being located within the corporation limits of the City of Columbus or the County of Franklin in official documents filed with Secretary of State, State of Ohio, or a valid vendor's license which indicates its place of business is located within the corporation limits of the City of Columbus or County of Franklin.

The successful bidder will supply and install twenty headers, made of eight (8) inch diameter black HDPE SDR-17 pipe (IPS), perforate to the specified schedule, and will cut and butt fuse forty (40) foot pipe sections and Reinforced HDPE Pipe Pulling Heads into straight air distribution headers. All HDPE shall be PE 3408 resin only. No excavation or tunneling services are included in this scope

The City of Columbus, Division of Sewerage and Drainage is requesting bids to fabricate high density polyethylene (HDPE) headers. The headers will be used by City employees to supply air to compost and control temperatures in compost piles to meet EPA requirements. City employees will excavate and place 3,200 feet of headers under compost piles to deliver air. Bidders are encouraged to inspect the 14,000 feet of existing HDPE headers in use. Composting mix with a bulk density of 1400 #/cu. yd. is placed on top of the header to a depth of 12 feet to uniformly draw air through the piles under negative aeration. Air drawn through the piles and pipe will compact material on top of the pipe and may reach temperatures as high as 70 degrees centigrade. Blower exhaust ports are 8 inches in diameter and will deliver air to two eight-inch headers. Pipe shall be delivered to the Compost Facility, 7000 Jackson Pike, Lockbourne, Ohio 43137 between the hours of 7 am and 2 pm Monday through Friday. Delivery shall be within 60 days after contract Notice to Proceed. Fabrication, drilling of holes, fusion of joints in the 40 foot sections of pipe may take place on-site at the Composting Facility. Two concrete pad locations for fabrication are identified for the contractor to use as a staging and fabrication work area. The first area is Composting Pad 3 located east of the Mechanized Mixing Building (60' x 150'), the second is the pipe storage area just east of the Equipment Storage Building.
