Each proposal shall contain the full name and address of every person, firm or corporation interested in the same, and if corporation, the name and address of the President and Secretary.

EQUAL OPPORTUNITY CLAUSE: Each responsive bidder shall submit, with its bid, a contract compliance certification number or a completed application for certification. Compliance with the provisions of Article I, Title 39, is a condition of the contract. Failure to comply with this Article may result in cancellation of the contract.

WITHHOLDING OF INCOME TAX: All bidders are advised that in order for a contract to bind the City, each contract must contain the provisions found in Section 361.34 C.C.C. with regard to income taxes due or payable to the City of Columbus for wages, salaries and commissions paid to the contractor's employees as well as requiring those contractors to ensure that subcontractors withhold in a like manner.

In determining the lowest bid for purposes of awarding a contract in excess of \$20,000.00, a local bidder shall receive a credit equal to one percent (1%) or \$20,000.00, whichever is less, of the lowest bid submitted by a non-local bidder. DEMOLITION AND SITE CLEARANCE - WOODLAND MEADOWS PROJECT

SCOPE AND CLASSIFICATION: The City of Columbus is seeking bids for demolition and site clearance work. The project consists of the removal of 122 brick multi unit apartment buildings and two maintenance buildings. The complex is located west of James Road, East of Gould Road, South of Allegheny Avenue, and North of Ruhl Avenue within the City of Columbus Ohio. The parcel number is 010-080166-00. The entire area consists of 52.151 acres.

The proposed services include the demolition and removal of every building, wall, walk, cistern, fence, garden, bush, rock, or an object whatsoever, located on the surface or subsurface of the parcel(s). All services shall be furnished to the acceptance of the City, and to the satisfaction of the requesting Department Director or designated City representative.

Adherence to all applicable City, State and Federal laws shall be the responsibility of the bidder. City of Columbus, Ohio, Construction and Materials Specifications, Most Current Edition, Section 100-General Provisions, is hereby made a part of this bid proposal and any ensuing contract. Contractor must currently possess or obtain valid City of Columbus Demolition License prior to start of demolition work.

This contract will be subject to Prevailing Wage Requirements. Bid will be awarded to the lowest responsive, responsible, and best bidder as determined by the City of Columbus in accordance with Quality Construction Contractor requirements. It is the responsibility of the successful bidder to remove all existing hazardous material according to guidelines established by The State of Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and The Ohio Department of Health .
