

FRA-COLUMBUS ARRA RESURFACING PROJECT

The City of Columbus, Department of Public Service, contracts for street resurfacing and curb-ramp construction to improve ride quality, reduce street-maintenance expenses and serve as a means of renewing and prolonging the life of roads and highways.


This project was funded entirely by the **American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009** through a Local Public Agency agreement between the City and the Ohio Department of Transportation. Streets were selected from the Federal Aid Routes listing provided by the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission. Work on the nine streets below covers six neighborhoods throughout the city and will be completed by 2010.


