- A health checkup of the mother and baby by a registered nurse.
- Developmental Screenings
- Information about finding a source of medical care
- Information on normal baby growth, safety and nutrition.
- Information about important baby immunizations (shots).
- Ready to Read Program
- Interpretive services available.
- Confidential and culturally sensitive.
- Referral and linking to other services as needed.

- Teenage parents
- Single parents
- Mothers delivering at the Ohio State University, Riverside, Grant, Doctors or Dublin Methodist.
