Policy Issues

- Priority Issues:
 - a. Bike May Use Full Lane Sign Location Criteria
 - b. Allow bicyclists to share bus/taxi lanes on High St Downtown
- Alum Creek Drive (Williams to Livingston)
- Require new developments to connect to transportation network via side streets or bike paths.
- Include representative from Franklin County Engineer on technical advisory group for BBP update
- Use of alleys on bike routes (Downtown and Sullivant Ave)
- Street Maintenance
 - a. Bike Lanes Street Sweeping Policy
 - b. On-street Bike Facilities Snow Removal Policy
- West Broad St Wrong Way Riders
- Enforcement for cyclists to not ride on sidewalks and other areas that are prohibited
- Allow bikes on Marconi railroad crossing in Arena District

Proposed Projects

- Make symbols for bike detectors more visible
- Review 77 Project Recommendations Spreadsheet from first Subcommittee Meeting
- Access Connections to Alum Creek Trail
 - a. West off of Sunbury Rd just north of Agler Road bridge (SR 1301225986)
 - b. South off of Agler Road, just west of Agler Road bridge
 - c. South off of Sunbury Dr, west off Sunbury Rd
 - d. East of Frebis from Integrity Dr S (SR 1106281182)
 - e. Johnstown Rd to Alum Creek Trail near Airport Dr (SR 910087492)
- Add trailhead parking for access to Alum Creek trail at Performance Way/Old Refugee Rd near Alum Creek Drive.
- Intersection Improvements to Alum Creek Trail (Add warning signs to freeway off ramps where there are trail crossings parallel or perpendicular to the ramp intersection)

- a. Alum Creek Trail @ Livingston Ave (SR 910087490)
 - b. Alum Creek Trail @ Main St (SR 910087491)
 - c. I-670 @ Leonard Ave (SR 910077272)
 - d. I-670 @ 5th Ave (SR 910077271)

 - f. Alum Creek Trail @ Easton Way and Sunbury Drive (SR 1012301098 – convoluted and dangerous bike crossing)
- Bikeway Improvements on Gantz Road bridge over I-270
 - Bike Connection from College and Petzinger Shared-Use Path crossing to Winchester Pike
 - Sullivant Ave – Norton Rd to Georgesville Rd, paved shoulder or bike lane
 - Steele Ave Bike Blvd EB Extension to Broad St
 - Scioto Blvd conversion to bike path – Greenlawn Ave to I-71
 - Whittier Street Shared/Signed Route – Scioto Audubon Metropark to Driving Park
 - Newton-Gault Bike Boulevard
 - South 3rd Street south of Livingston Avenue
 - Civic Center Dr @ Broad St – Bike Crossing
 - Carl Schoolman’s Hunter Ave Bike Blvd
 - 3rd Ave @ Olentangy River Road – adjust loop detector sensitivity for bicycles
 - 3rd Ave @ Olentangy Trail – Ramp access to trail
 - Route 2 Olentangy Trail to Upper Arlington – sign is missing at the intersection of Rudy Rd and Overlook Dr (SR 1301225987)
 - Bike Connection from King Avenue to Lennox Town Center
 - Indianola Ave Bike Blvd – Fifth Ave to Chittenden Ave
 - Remove parking blocks near bike parking shelter at High St and 17th Ave
 - Calumet St Bike Blvd or other bike treatment
 - Walhalla Road conversion to bike boulevard
 - Milton Ave @ Delhi Ave and Kenworth Rd – investigate issues with cyclist stop sign compliance
 - Bike Path Connection – Clearview Ave to Olentangy Trail
 - Neighborhood route south of Henderson Rd to bridge over SR-315 / Olentangy River
 - Innis Road paved shoulders on bridge over Alum Creek
 - Convert Westerville Rd paved shoulders to bike lane – Innis Rd to Morse Rd and north of Morse Rd to SR-161
 - Bike Lanes on Easton Way between Alum Creek Trail and Stelzer Rd
 - Lane control sign update on Morse Road near Northland
 - Convert Morse Road paved shoulders to bike lane – Sunbury Road to Hamilton Road
 - Bike lanes or sharrows along Tamarack Blvd between Morse Rd and Tamarack Circle
 - Bethel Rd side paths – Olentangy Greenway to Scioto River
 - Connect Broadmeadows Bridge to Rush Run Park and Delewanda Park along with adjacent neighborhoods
 - Connection across CSX RR tracks from Smallwood Dr to Kempton Run Drive using existing tunnels

- Bikeway from east of Schrock Rd / I-270 to Park Rd / Worthington-Galena Rd
- Bikeway connection from Gemini Place to E Powell Rd

Programmed Projects

- Bike Connection from Scioto Trail to Twin Rivers Drive (2013)
- Spot Improvement: Alum Creek Trail @ Livingston Ave (2013)
- Inventory of signed shared roadways (2013)
- Olentangy to Alum Creek Connector Phase II (2015)

Completed

- Bike Lockers (2012)
- SR 1011238350 – “Bike Lane Ends” sign on Morse Rd needs to be moved east now that the bike lane has been extended (2012)
- Lane Ave Sharrows (High St to Olentangy River Road) (2011)
- High St Sharrows (Morse Rd to northern corp. line) (2011)
- Loops requested for Henderson @ Olentangy Blvd (north & south approaches)
- Allow through bicyclists to use shared use paths 24 hours (or longer than sunrise to sunset), recommendation 5.5.4 in BBP (Metroparks to allow 24 hour trail access to commuters)
- Investigate language duplication in Columbus Traffic Code 2173.04(C) and 2173.07(C) regarding bicyclists riding to the right side.
