Ohio Department of Job & Family Services requires all licensed child care centers and Type A Homes to have at least one person on site at the center who has completed the 6-hour with Communicable Disease training (required by Rules 5101:2-12-27 and 5101:2-13-27). A 3-hour refresher course is required every 3 years. Columbus Public Health and the Franklin County Public Health are offering the following courses free of charge:

6-Hour Course
