

COST

- Walk-in pregnancy tests are done at scheduled hours only.
- The program uses a sliding fee scale for all services and medications for uninsured clients.
- Our program accepts cash, checks, and the following insurances: Medicaid, Care-Source, Molina, United Health Care and Medicare. There is an ATM machine in the lobby.
- We do not accept credit cards.

WITH EACH VISIT YOU'LL NEED TO BRING:

- Picture ID
- Proof of income
- Household family information
- Insurance card, only if insured

PREGNANCY SERVICES

- Pregnancy care
- Pregnancy tests
- Healthy Start/Healthy Families applications
- Pregnancy social worker services
- Case management and referrals

WELL WOMAN HEALTH SERVICES

- Annual women's health exams
- Focused exams, including screenings for breast cancer, cervical cancer, and sexually transmitted infections
- Family planning services and birth control with referral
- Women's health risk assessments, counseling and referrals
- Clinic interpreter services
