TRANSPORTATION SERVICE PROVIDER BATTERY ELECTRIC VEHICLE REBATE PROGRAM APPLICATION

PROGRAM SUMMARY

The City of Columbus has allocated \$30,000 of Paul G. Allen Family Foundation grant funds to support deployment of battery electric vehicles in the seven-county Greater Columbus region (Franklin county and the six contiguous counties) through the Smart Columbus Transportation Service Provider Battery Electric Vehicle Rebate Program (Program). The program will provide rebates to qualified applicants. Applicants will be selected for participation in the program based on overall application alignment with the program goals. Actual rebate payments will be made after purchase(s), delivery and deployment is complete. Interested parties may apply to participate in this program as described below.

GENERAL PARTICIPATION AND REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants must be Transportation Service Providers. Transportation Service Providers (TSP) for the first round of this program are defined as traditional taxis services.
- Applicants must complete a program application and provide all required information. Clean Fuels Ohio, on behalf of the Smart Columbus program office, can assist applicants in understanding the application, process and required documentation.
- In developing an application, applicants must clearly demonstrate alignment with the following Program goals:
 - Fleet Adoption
 - Deployment of new battery electric vehicles (BEV)
 - Maximizing BEV miles driven, trips taken, and number of passengers in each trip
 - Increasing and maintaining this increase of the ratio of internal combustion engine (ICE) vehicle to BEVs in your fleet
 - Consumer Exposure
 - Increasing consumer interaction and education related to BEVs
 - Increasing marketing exposure for BEVs
 - Gathering and analyzing data related to BEV usage and customer experience
- Upon selection for participation in the Program, applicants must sign a program agreement.

FUNDING LEVELS AND REQUIREMENTS

• Each applicant may receive a rebate of up to \$3,000 per new, BEV, up to the total program amount of \$30,000.

BATTERY ELECTRIC VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS

- Battery electric vehicle must be a new car purchase that is registered with the Ohio Department of Public Safety - Bureau of Motor Vehicles and may not be a low or underspeed vehicle as defined by ORC 4501.01.
- Vehicle must be fully electric
- Vehicles must operate with-in the seven-county Greater Columbus region.
 It is expected that these vehicles will occasionally accept a fare that

travels out of the seven-county region. Any miles traveled outside of the region should not be calculated on the monthly data collection form.

- Vehicles must track and share data monthly (see draft form Appendix A)
 - Miles Driven Carrying a Fare
 - Other Miles Driven
 - Number of Trips Taken
 - Number of Passengers Per Trip

FUNDING AND REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants need to be pre-approved by TSP Rebate Committee prior to purchasing the BEV.
- Funds will be reserved upon approval of the application and the applicant's and City's approval of the program agreement documents, as administered by Clean Fuels Ohio. The funds will then be awarded in two installments to those selected applicants following the BEV purchase, delivery and deployment. Half of the rebate amount will be paid within 30 days of the purchase of the BEV. The second installment will be paid 30 days after the end of the twelfth month and after submission of all required monthly reports. Applicants will have four months to complete the purchase, delivery and deployment steps, after which reserved funding will be released to be used toward other applicants or projects. Applicants can reapply for funding.
- All rebates are subject to funding availability. Awardees must provide monthly reports to include data on utilization as written above, marketing/educational efforts and any useful feedback from the driver or customers that can provide lessons learned and development of best practices.

SCORING

Applications will be scored based on how well the applicant meets the Program goals listed in the General Participation and Requirements section.
